
Covid-19 Bus Cleaning Protocol



As part of the control measures in place to reduce the risk of spreading the coronavirus, the company buses will be requiring a clean after every use. This is to ensure there is less risk to the children being transported to school and the out of school clubs.

The drivers will be expected to keep supplies of cleaning materials in the boot of the vehicle that will be used to clean the vehicle after each use and a deep clean at the end of the week to ensure it is ready for use.

The cleaning equipment to be used will include:

- Aprons
- Masks
- Gloves
- Disinfectant/Anti-bacterial products
- disposable cloths for use each time the bus is cleaned.

Staff members who are responsible for cleaning the buses will ensure all the following areas are cleaned before and after each use.

- All handles on the inside and the outside of the bus
- Steering wheel
- Seatbelt buckles and seatbelt strap
- Touchscreen interface inside the front of the bus
- All windows cleaned on the inside and outside of the bus
- All booster seats will be wiped down before and after each use.
- Seats are wiped down after each use.
- Any other area that the driver feels should be cleaned that is not listed.

A checklist will be provided for drivers to mark off when they have cleaned the bus and they can sign when done after every bus cleaning. This will support in ensuring the buses are clean when they are in use.
