
Covid-19 Temperature Checking Protocol



In line with recent government guidelines in regard to the Covid-19 outbreak, we will be carrying out temperature checks on all children who attend the setting. If a child is found to have a temperature of 38 degrees or higher, they will be sent home and not allowed into the setting.

The same condition will apply for any child found to be displaying symptoms of Covid-19.

The temperature checks will be carried out when they reach their bubble. We are asking parents not to enter the building and wait outside the premises until the check has been carried out.

Staff will be using appropriate protection equipment including masks and gloves when carrying out these checks, they are being used for the protection of staff and the children themselves and to reduce the risk of potentially spreading the virus.

Staff checking temperatures will report any children with a high temperature or fever to the manager so the situation can be assessed, and measures can be put into place. This is being done for the protection and health of all staff and children in the setting.

Children who do not have a temperature will be allowed into the setting and expected to follow all protocols and policies in place regarding the control measures for Covid-19.
