

Candystripe Collection Protocol with regards to COVID-19 Crisis



All Schools involved St Pauls, St Urbans, St Matthews, Chapel Allerton, Talbot, Moortown, Gledhow and Immaculate Heart Primary School

Please read carefully and reply by email to say you have fully understood the issues raised or please raise your issues immediately:

It is vital you understand that if we are able to collect your children, there is a health and safety protocol that both parent and staff must adhere to:

All children will have to have their temperature checked, any child or staff member with a temperature 38 or above will not be allowed in the setting.

Children from the schools mentioned above will be collected from the school, given a Hi-Vis vest and then transported by minibus to The Cottage on Harrogate Road.

Once onsite they will be informed of the rules regarding social distancing and hand hygiene, and again their temperatures will at this point be taken.

When collecting your child, you will be asked to stay in the reception area for the safety of both staff and children.

If we call to ask you collect your child, you must do so immediately. Your child may be isolated (safely and appropriately) whilst waiting with support from the team.

All children will be cared for at Candystripe Cottage site which is set up with a full time cleaner concentrating in cleanliness at all times.

All children will have to follow health and hygiene rules laid out in the club and this will be carried out as calmly and nicely as possible so children do not feel anxious.

Your child/children will be collected by staff trained in company minibuses. These minibuses are cleaned down before and after every journey. We will be working with the schools on timings of collections but these may vary dependent on the amount of children needing our support.

Slight changes for St Matthew and Chapel Allerton Primary School due to walking buses

The same as above for your children with the exception that they will be taken to setting as usual with staff member walking them.

St Matthews ams and Immaculate Heart ams will be taken to school in the usual manner.

Again, to say that ALL children and staff will have their temperature checked before entering the site.

You must agree to this procedure for us to be able to care for you child by returning an email to say "I can confirm I fully understand the protocol above and will work with Candystripe at all times adhering to the rules laid out within"
